ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING SNA CERTIFIED?

Even if you have not had either of the two (2) ten (10) hours required classes, you will have the opportunity to do so at the seating of the 2012 SNA of SC Annual Conference and Expo. We will offer two sessions each of Nutrition 101 and HACCP in South Carolina's Schools. **(These two 10 hour classes are replacing ServSafe and Building Healthy Habits.)** This will allow you to obtain your Level I Certification in June.

The requirements for Level 1 Certification will change beginning July 1, 2012. Individuals applying for Level 1 Initial Certification will be required to submit a copy of their High School Diploma/GED along with their Core Course documentation and application beginning July 1st. Please inform your staff and individuals in your state about the upcoming change.

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO BECOME SNA CERTIFIED AT THE CONFERENCE:

1. Complete the conference registration form~~also available on line at: www.schoolnutritionsc.org
2. Make sure that you check one or both classes (Nutrition 101 and/or HACCP in SC Schools). There is no additional cost for the classes when you register for the conference.
3. The complete schedule for these two classes is as follows; however, you will receive your individual schedule by email prior to the conference and in your registration packet.

(May need to adjust times. Sunday's class will be eliminated if possible).
4. Attend the session on Thursday morning from 9:00-10:00 a.m. to complete the necessary documents to forward to National.
5. ***If you have already taken ServSafe or Building Healthy Habits (must be within the past five years), please bring your certificate to the conference to forward to National with the certification form.***
6. Please note that if you need both required classes, you will not be able to take the other classes that will be offered during the conference. You will be able to attend all general sessions and special events. Additionally, your expo time will be limited on Wednesday.
